#### 6. Fundraising

Spirit Wear – total sales of \$15,098, not sure on profit yet. Items should be delivered in the next 2 weeks and will be sent home with the students.

Save-On Gift Cards – we will be running this fundraiser before Christmas and we would like to also give the opportunity to purchase gift cards which can be donated to Salvation Army.

### 7. Questions/Discussion
