Arriving Late to School

Parents/Guardians, we could use your support with students arriving late to school after the 9:01 start time. We have been noticing an increase in the number of students arriving after the start time bell. Arriving late is disruptive to your child, their peers, and school staff.

If your child does arrive late:

- Remind your child they are to check-in at the Welcome Centre (Office) to receive an Admit Slip
- Proceed directly to class after receiving the Admit Slip
- Give the Admit Slip directly to their teacher

We appreciate any support you can provide to prevent late arrivals. Please contact the school if you are needing assistance with your child in this regard.

Parents, we could use your support with students leaving school early.

We have been noticing an increase in students leaving before the scheduled end of the day and this is disruptive to classes and to your child's learning. However, we understand that there are times when extracurricular sports, appointments and emergencies make early dismissal unavoidable. If your student needs to leave early, we would ask you to help us out with the following:

- Please use the School Messenger App to let our office staff know what time your child needs to leave.
- Please remind your child when they should be leaving the school and that they need to check out at the office. Sometimes parents contact the office staff to remind students they need to leave. Calling multiple times at the end of the day into communities is disruptive to the teachers and the learners they are caring for.


