- 3. Administration Update Jim Laird, Principal and Carson Tonn, Vice Principal

- -funds raised this year 18,600 hot lunch (about halfway there), \$30,000 raised and gaming grant \$14,000, doing well, \$521 pancake breakfast, costs down, reminders to teachers to get receipts in soon, good fundraisers coming up
- -Domino's pizza, how are the funds coming to the school, \$5 from package to school, some confusion as to how it works

- -Possibility of running Spirit Wear again, special hoodie for Grade 8's?, community themed t-shirts, possibility of donating gently used spirit wear back to the school
